

Puri Bhubaneswar Package

ITINERARY # 1 (03 Nights / 04 days

Day 1: Arrival at Bhubaneswar

Upon Arrival transfer to hotel. Later if time permit proceed for half day local sightseeing of tribal museum (closed on Monday), Khandagiri & Udaigiri Jain caves (oldest rock cut caves; the caves are reminiscent of influence of Buddhism and Jainism in Orissa). Overnight stay at Bhubaneswar.

Day 2: Bhubaneswar

After breakfast visit to famous city temples including Lingaraj, Parsurameswar, Mukteswar (Mukteswar temple, the 'Gem of Orissa Architecture'), Rajarani temple. In the evening visit Nandankanan Zoo (closed on Monday). This Zoo is famous for the white tiger safari and Botanical Garden. Overnight stay at Bhubaneswar.

Day 3: Bhubaneswar – Konark - Puri

After breakfast drive to Puri, en-route visit Dhauli (Budhist Stupa / Peace Pagoda), Pipli (the appliqué work village) and Konark Sun Temple (Famous as black Pagoda), then proceed to Puri and check in to the hotel. In the evening visit Lord Jagannath Temple (Non Hindus are not allowed)/Relax on the golden beach of Puri. Overnight stay at Puri.

Day 4: Puri – Bhubaneswar

After B/fast depart to Bhubaneswar airport /railway station for onward Journey.

Day 02: Bhubaneswar

After breakfast visit famous city temples including Lingaraj, Parsurameswar, Mukteswar temple, Rajarani temple. Evening visit to Nandankanan Zoo (closed on Monday) .This Zoo is famous for the white tiger safari and Botanical Garden. Overnight stay at Bhubaneswar.

Day 3: Bhubaneswar – Konark – Puri

After breakfast drive to Puri. En-route visit Dhauli (Budhist stupa/ peace pagoda), Pipli (the appliqué work village) and Konark Sun Temple (known as black pagoda). Then proceed to Puri and check in to the hotel. Evening visit of Lord Jagannath Temple (Non Hindus are not allowed) / Relax on the golden beach of puri. Overnight stay at Puri.

Day 4: Puri – Chilika - Puri

After B/fast drive to Chilika Lake at Satpada. Take the boat cruise to visit the Irrawaddy for a glimpse of Dolphins. Back to Puri. Evening visit market. Overnight stay at Puri.

Day 5: Puri – Bhubaneswar for departure transfer.

After B/fast departure to Bhubaneswar airport /railway station for onward Journey.
